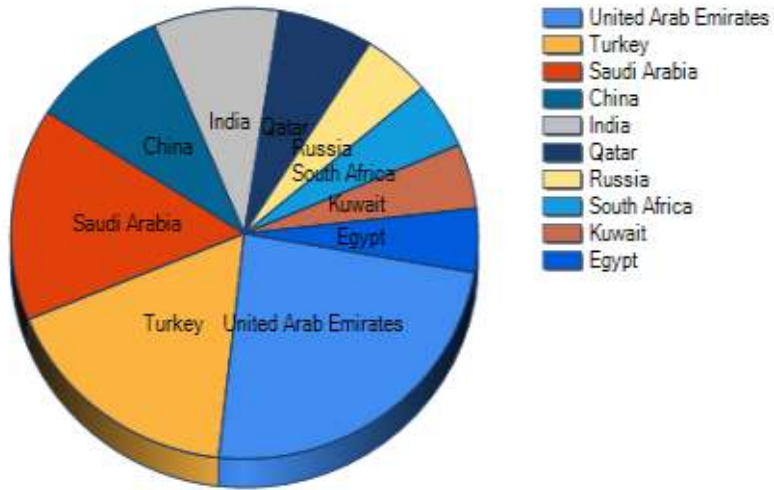

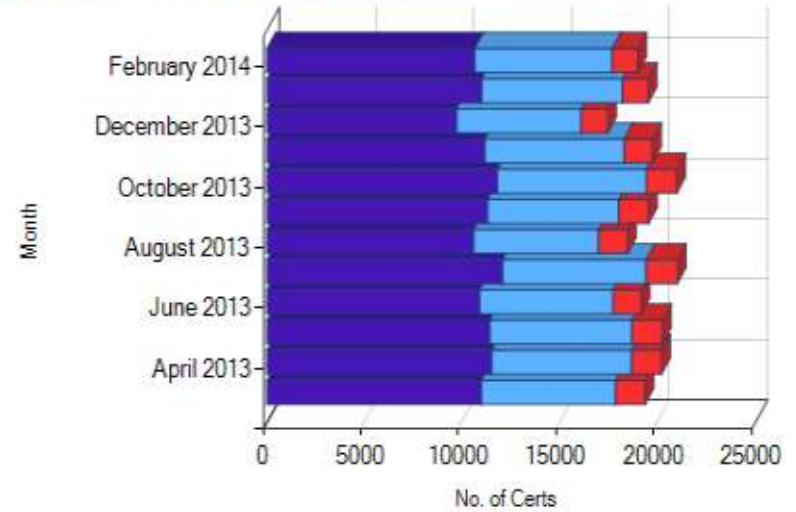


Top Ten Export Destinations (12 Months)

## Intrastat Reporting

If your trade in goods within the EU exceeds £1,200,000 for Arrivals and/or £250,000 for Dispatches in a calendar year then you are required by law to submit monthly Intrastat Supplementary Declarations (SDs) to HMRC.
